

# **HUMBOLDT COUNTY JOB POSTING**

## **ALTERNATE PUBLIC DEFENDER**

Humboldt County seeks a qualified individual to serve as the Alternate Public Defender in Winnemucca, Nevada. The Alternate Public Defender will be responsible for providing representation to the County's indigent accused in juvenile, misdemeanor, neglect, and parole/probation revocation proceedings originating in the Union Township Justice Court and the Sixth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada, from inception to ultimate disposition. The Alternate Public Defender will represent participants in diversion courts and serve as first tier felony Conflict Counsel.

The candidate must be a self-starter, team player and ready and willing to work independently, and have a good knowledge of the principles, methods, materials, practices, and references utilized in legal research. The candidate will have the ability to draft pleadings, briefs, plea agreements, correspondence, and orders, and have the ability to establish and maintain effective working relation with court officials, county officials, and the general public. The candidate must be licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada and reside in Winnemucca, Nevada. A 2 year commitment is requested.

Humboldt County offers a competitive benefits package in addition to salary of \$62,000 – \$80,000.
