

**NOTICE OF FUNDING AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR DISCUSSION OF  
POSSIBLE STATE CDBG-CV2 & CDBG-CV3 APPLICATIONS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Humboldt County Board of Commissioners will conduct a public hearing on March 16, 2021, at 8:30 a.m. at the Humboldt County Courthouse Meeting Room 201, 50 W. Fifth Street, Winnemucca, Nevada, to discuss possible applications for funding from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Nevada Community Development Block Grant Covid Program and solicit citizen input on possible activities for the County's applications. The Public can join the public hearing on March 16, 2021, at 8:30 via attending in person, telephonically or virtually.

The CDBG-CV2 grant is accepting proposals from eligible nonprofits that need funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19 in an amount not to exceed \$57,850.00 guaranteed to Humboldt County nonprofits.

The CDBG-CV3 grant is accepting proposals from eligible nonprofit and for-profit businesses and housing authorities that need funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19 in an amount not to exceed \$2, 474, 984.00 available to eligible entities within the State of Nevada.

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS WILL PREVENT, PREPARE FOR, AND RESPOND TO THE CORONAVIRUS; AND MUST MEET AT LEAST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA: 1.BENEFIT TO LOW-MODERATE INCOME HOUSEHOLDS OR PERSONS; 2.ELIMINATION OF SLUMS AND BLIGHT; OR 3. MEETS URGENT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS.

- Public services to respond to COVID-19 impacts
- Public facility improvements to increase capacity for healthcare facilities
- Housing facilities for persons experiencing homelessness
- Economic development to support needs of local businesses to retain and bring back jobs impacted by COVID-19

This NOFA includes specifics including an expenditure period of 24 months, that these funds are not a duplication of services or funding, and that all CDBG requirements be met, including the expenditure of all CDBG Program Income would be expended during the grant period. Proposals are due by March 16, 2021, depending on the application activity. Funding from the CDBG-CV2 and CDBG-CV3 do not require local match. Funds for the administration of the program are included in the funding allocation.

This funding requires two public hearings. The purpose of this first public hearing on March 16, 2021 8:30 a.m. is a call for project submissions meeting eligibility requirements. Upon receiving confirmation of project eligibility from the Governor's Office of Economic Development, applications will need to be completed by April 27,

2021 and Humboldt County staff will return to the Board of Commissioners at a final hearing for discussion, ranking and approval of applications for Round Two funding or sponsoring the application(s) for the competitive Round Three funding. Notice of the final Public Hearing date to be posted and published April 14, 2021.

The Humboldt County Board of Commissioners promotes fair housing and makes all its programs available to low- and moderate-income families regardless of age, race, color, relation, sex, national origin, sexual preference, marital status or handicap.
